The Association has a Finance Committee meeting on Tuesday, June 20th as well as a Disciplinary Committee meeting on Wednesday, June 21st. As Pool Season gets into full swing, I must give my summer announcement. Please remind all children that the blue and white safety line in the pool is required by the Florida State Health Department and is made to break to prevent tangling anyone up. If the safety line gets pulled apart, the pool is closed by law, until the maintenance staff can either repair it or have a replacement ordered at the expense of the household that was responsible for it breaking. The other important rule because the pool is required to meet the community pool safety regulations, is no running around the pool or jumping, flipping, or diving into the pool. We don't want to see anyone get hurt, but it seems to be inevitable that someone will fall and get hurt, and if the injury results in bleeding, the pool must be closed until it can be chemically treated, and the deck area cleaned and sanitized. It is much better for everyone to go home safe, uninjured and the pool stays open instead of closed for cleaning.



What you need to know about your Bill Pay set up!

Bill Pay typically takes 7-10 business days for Cadence Bank or LPEE to receive. Even if your bank states that the payment will be received by a specific date, that is not always the case. To help ensure your payments are processed in a timely manner you will want to set up your Bill Pay accordingly:

2433, LPE, your lot number


\*\*If you are not sure what your lot number is please call the office at 996-4441\*\*
