#### **MANAGER'S REPORT**

LPEE Residents,

We are still in the middle of the summer heat, hopefully everyone has had a chance to use the pool. Please, remember, the property is available for all the members and their registered guests. There is a guest sign in sheet available in the office and Lounge. The guest fee is \$5 for the whole day. You can walk around the track early in the morning when the temperatures are cooler, then swim in the afternoons to take the edge off the daily heat. A member must be present with the guest when they are using the grounds or facilities. The member is ultimately responsible for the guest's actions.

Monday September 5th is our annual Labor Day picnic from 12 pm till 5 pm. The hot dogs and hamburgers are being provided by The Hideout Lounge, and sides will be provided by residents. If you bring a side you can eat for free, if you don't bring a side, then you can pay \$5. You are welcome to bring guests, they will have to pay the \$5 guest fee, but they can bring a side or pay an additional \$5 for the food.

Please remember, the Florida State Health Department regulates the Association's pool, and therefore the State's Rules must be followed, or the Association can lose their permit and have to close down the pool. So, no glass or breakable containers are allowed anywhere in the pool area. No food or drinks in the pool or on the edge of the pool, those items must be kept more than 4 feet away from the pool. Nothing along the edge of the pool that could pose a trip hazard. The blue and white safety line (rope) indicating the deep end of the pol is required by the Health Department. If the line breaks, the pool must be shut down, and the member is responsible for the costs to replace it. The pool is here for all the residents to enjoy, and staff are required to ask to see your membership ID, and to see


