### **MANAGER'S REPORT**

Happy Halloween LPEE,

This month will be a busy one, the new pool gate will be installed along with the magnetic locks. The ID cards are scheduled to be delivered in the second week of October, so by the end of October we will be able to start issuing the new ID cards and activating the magnetic locks.

The Association was not able to reach the 60% participation in the election for the Amendments. The number of submitted votes needs to reach 675 in order to qualify as a quorum. There were just over 200 proxies submitted, less than one-third of the 675 needed. Only after a quorum is reached can they be tallied to see what the majority voted for. If you haven't submitted your signed proxy, please due that as soon as you can, the Association has 90 days to reopen the election if a quorum is reached. It is important that you have a say in what changes take place in Lake Padgett Estates East and if either of these Amendments are important to you, please ask your neighboring homeowners to fill out and submit their proxies if they haven't done that yet.

As far as activities are concerned, October will be busy as well. The Board meets on Monday the 9th and Monday the 23rd. The social committee will be holding Bingo on Wednesday Octobter 11th, and Trunk or Treat on Saturday October 28th. The Hideout Lounge is having their Halloween party on Friday October 27th. The Community is having its fall yard

sale on Saturday October 21st. If there is anything I missed, I apologize. Wishing everyone a fun and safe October.

# FREE!

The residents of Baldomero Lopez State Veterans Nursing Home need your assistance! 120 Veterans from World War II, Korean War, Vietnam War and Gulf War reside at the home. They receive \$35 a month to purchase every day, personal needs. For most residents, this is all the money they have.

Again this year, due to CDC guidelines, we have had to modify our donation list. The staff at Lopez needs to maintain PPE and other required supplies, therefore available storage has been drastically reduced for our use.

## The only items we can collect are:

- Depends Briefs & Men's Guards
- Boxes of Tissues
- Men's Stick Deodorant
- Men's Body Wash (or 3-in-1 Wash)
- Body Lotion (Regular size bottles)

## We are also collecting:

Gift Cards from Target, Walmart, Sam's Club, Costco, Publix, Dollar Tree, Amazon Checks made payable to Operation Patriot and cash donations

ALL donations will be used to provide personal care products, in bulk, incrementally throughout the year and other items needed by our Veterans. <u>HONOR OUR</u> <u>HEROES!</u>

LPEE is collecting donations at this year's Trunk Or Treat at the clubhouse on October 28th, 2023 from 4:30pm-6pm



Operation Patriot is a small, all volunteer charity comprised of employees and retirees of the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office. We began this charity in 2004 to provide a way to better the quality of life of our aging heroes who are spending their last years at the Baldomero Lopez State Veterans Nursing Home (BLSVNH). It is located in Land O' Lakes and is the regional nursing home for this area of Florida, near our community, at the corner of Parkway Blvd and Ehren Cutoff.

We identified a need that was all but forgotten in our elderly veterans' home. Very few, if any, organizations exist to support the veteran heroes of our former wars, which include: WWII, Korea, Vietnam, and the original Gulf War. Many of us do not realize that the State has adopted the same dollar allowance as Medicaid for these items, which include toothpaste, toothbrushes, denture products, incontinence products (Depends type items), hand lotion, etc. This allowance is only \$35.00 per month. As many of you who have purchased these items know, this is not enough.

We began conducting a product drive for personal care products within businesses and schools in Hillsborough County, delivering between 250—400 boxes each Veterans Day to the home.

As time progressed we identified needs to assist the aging residents in their final years. We provide the funding for entertainers to perform for the residents seven times a month. We installed and maintain a computer system (stand alone) with internet access, along with Netflix and Skype capabilities. We provided several large screen televisions in common areas and diningrooms. We also provide numerous themed parties and BBQ events throughout the year, along with purchasing individual personalized Christmas gifts for each of the 120 Veterans, given to them at our annual Christmas party.

In the past, with the assistance of the staff at BLSVNH, the donated items were stored and used as needed for the residents. Due to Covid-19 and the need to maintain PPE and other needed supplies, available storage has been drastically reduced for our use.

Again this year we are accepting donations of Depends briefs and guards, boxes of tissues, men's stick deodorant, men's body wash, and body lotion. We are also accepting gift cards for Target, Walmart, Sam's Club, Costco, Publix, Dollar Tree, and Amazon: checks made payable to Operation Patriot: and monetary donations. All donations will be used to provide quality personal care products in bulk, throughout the year, along with other needed items for our Veterans.

WE ARE ALL VOLUNTEER, no one receives any compensation in any manner for our work. The donations we receive go to our goals, with very little (less than 4%) going toward operating costs.

In 2007 we incorporated as a charity in the State of Florida and we have attained a 501(c)(3) status with the IRS, which allows donors to have a tax deduction when they contribute to our organization.

## LIST OF VIOLATIONS

Following is a list of the violations of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions: Mail Box, Commercial Vehicle, Unattended Dog, Driveway in Need of Repair, Roof Eaves, Fence Repair/Paint, Garage Door in need of Repair, Hedges in need of Trimming, Illegal Fence, Vehicle up on Jacks, Lot Maintenance, Mildew, Noxious and Illegal Activity, Painting, No Permission, Parking, Roof Cleaning, Roof Repair, Screen in need of Repair, Signs, Untagged Vehicle, Trash Cans, Tree and/or Limbs need pruning, Tree Removal, Unsightly Items, Window AC Unit.

It is important that we all inspect our properties to ensure we are clear of these violations. As the temperature begins to decline now is the best time to get some of these home improvements done to avoid citations from the Architectural Board. Please keep in mind that any exterior modifications need approval.
